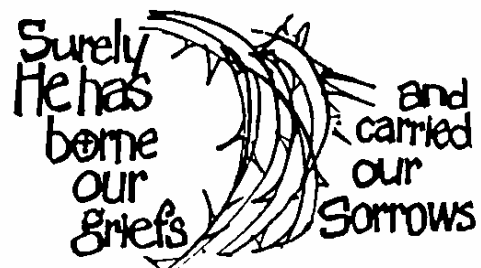

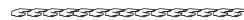


OUR MOTHER'S DAY GIFT TO OUR MOTHER
