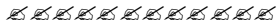

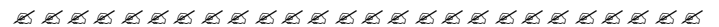
Donations can also be dropped off on Friday, April 19, from 2-6pm or Saturday, April 20 at 7am in the A Wing of the old Ed building.

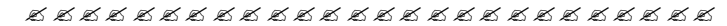

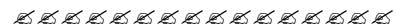
