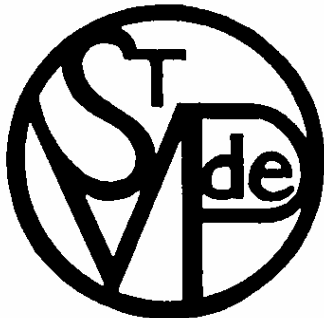

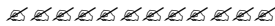

Please start thinking of new items or nearly new items for our auction. Let's make this auction a rousing success for our Mother Church, St. Mary's. More information to follow soon.

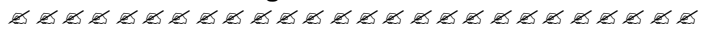
