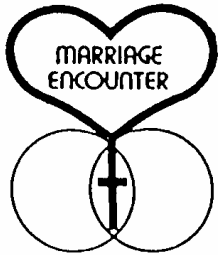

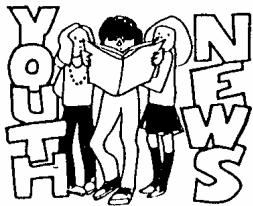
RELIGIOUS EDUCATION NEWS

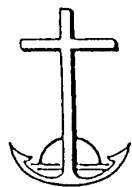
