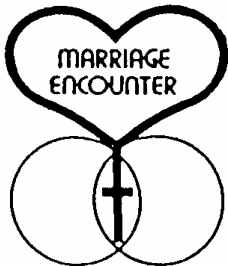

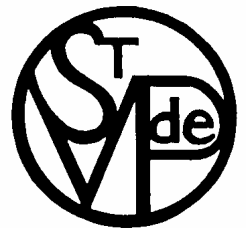
"Give and Gifts Will Be Given to You"
