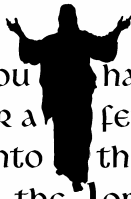

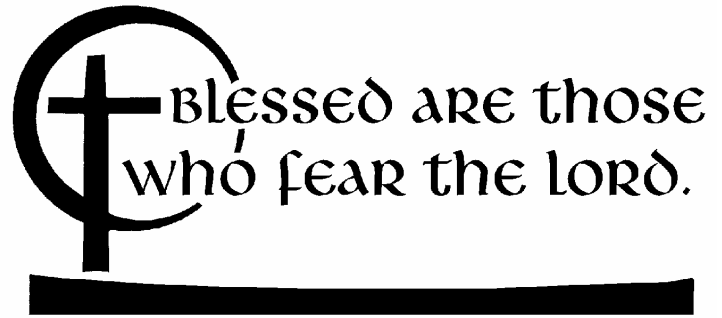

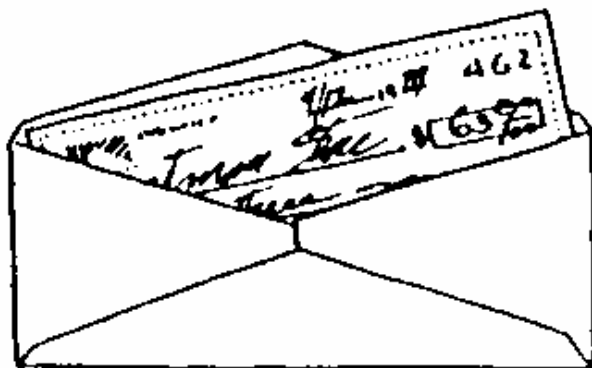
There are still lots of Directories left. Have you gotten yours? Please stop by the office, Monday thru Friday, 9am to 4pm, and pick up your copy.
