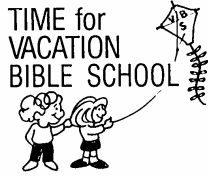

The Tribunal Office of the Diocese of Galveston-Houston has revised its formal petition form for annulments. Beginning September 1, 2003, the Tribunal Office will only accept the newly revised petition form to apply for an annulment. If you have already begun to prepare to petition the Tribunal for an annulment, you MUST complete and submit the petition form that you are using by August 31, 2003. After that date, only the newly revised form will be accepted. Please consult your parish priest or deacon for clarification.
