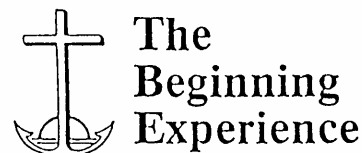

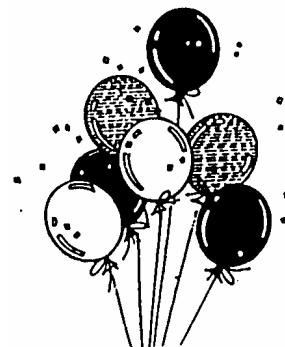
WE COULD USE YOUR HELP!
