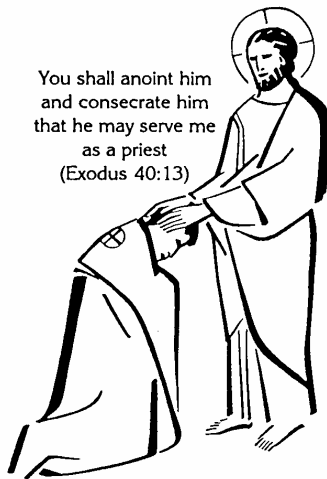

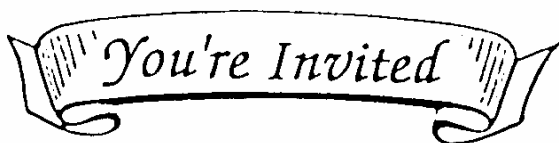
The Beginning Experience Weekend is designed to help men and women who are widowed, separated or
