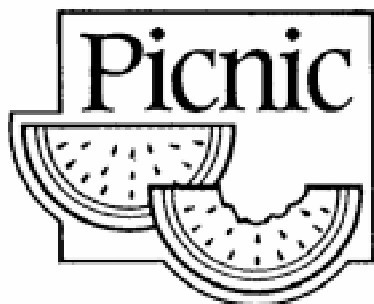


**Attention all Eucharistic
