**John Buettner** - planted and cared for the crepe myrtles in the back parking lot;

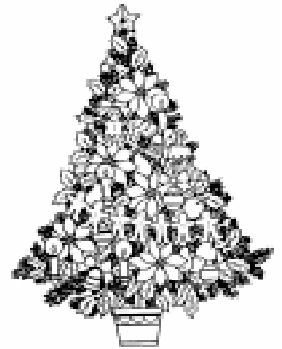
**Mike Futschik** - weeded and trimmed the ligustrum behind church on the Family Life Center side (even got poison ivy from it);
