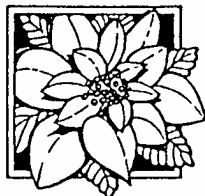
The Gabriel Project is sorely in need of gently used or new baby items such as cribs, strollers and infant car seats.

Kroger Share Cards – New Bar Code Replacements
Kroger Share Cards and new self-adhesive bar codes are available in the back of the church for those having difficulty with the new Kroger scanners and for those needing new ones to attach to the front of their Kroger Plus Cards. Kroger donates one percent of purchases to St. Vincent de Paul when these bar codes are used. Similarly, Randall's and Food King also donate one percent of purchases. For **Randall's**, please use code number 10077 in the box for the Good Neighbor Program when applying for a Remarkable Card. For **Food King**, just place your receipts in the St. Vincent de Paul Food Basket in the hallway of the Family Life Center or enclose with your monthly grocery donation. These are donations by the food stores and do not increase your receipt total.
