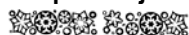

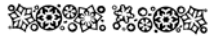
We regret that the St. Joseph’s Altar, planned for March 19 has been cancelled due to several complications. We’ll try again next year.

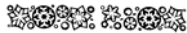

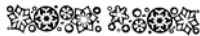

There is an open hour in the Chapel on Thursday, from 11am to 12noon. Please call Arlene Becker, 798-8388, if you are interested in this hour.

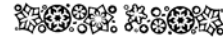
ATTENTION ALL VOLUNTEERS:

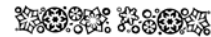
