ENVISION

Organizing Phase – We have almost finished the first phase of **ENVISION**. The last step is Focus Group meetings. Everyone should have signed up to participate in at least one group. These will end on June 11th. The Planning Team will gather all the data and present it on Listening Day, June 24th.

Listening Phase – The first big event in this phase is Listening Day. It is a six-hour work session for parish leaders and parishioners (as many as possible). The objective of the day is to work together to:

- Build** a common picture of where the parish is now.
- Discern** the call of God to become a more evangelizing parish.
- Identify** what we are pleased with in our parish today (Glads) and what we feel needs improvement (Sads).

At Listening Day, everyone will be given a rich store of data gathered by the Planning Team. There will be historical data, highlighting major events that have shaped the life of our parish. There will be demographic data about the current situation of the parish community and data resulting from the focus groups and the **ENVISION** Questionnaire. They will be guided to **listen for understanding**.
