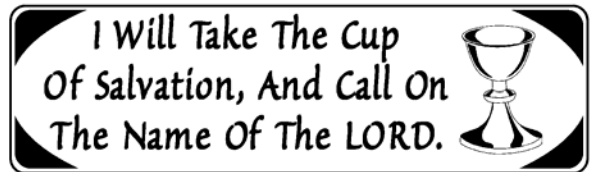
Protecting God's Children Workshop for Adults
