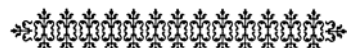

(Formation Toward Christian Ministry) is a program that offers basic theology and spiritual development to Catholics who want to deepen their commitment to Jesus and more fully answer their baptismal call to service. **Registration is underway** for classes that are offered at St. Anthony's in Danbury on Thursdays from 7:00—9:00 p.m., from **August 31st until December 14th**.
