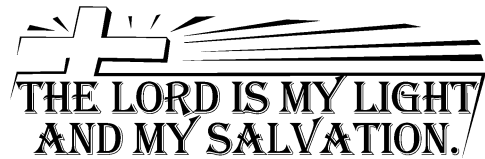
CENTRAL INFORMATION CENTER

Young Adult Bible study – Kick Off This Week

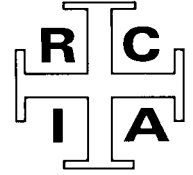
Come join the Young Adult Ministry (YAM) this Wednesday the 23rd
