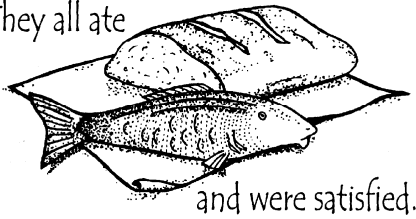


They all ate

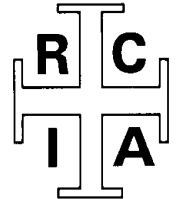
