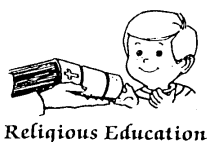
**Women of St. Michael's** invite you to join us, **Tuesday October 7, 2008** for our monthly meeting (day or evening meeting available).
