Dear Parish Families,

We are nearing the end of the catechetical school year and would like to thank you for the opportunity to be partners in the faith formation of your child/children. At this time, we must also begin preparing for next year's program, in order to effectively budget and prepare for the upcoming year.

There will be several schedule changes for next year's classes.

CCE:K-6th

Wed. - 6:15pm to 7:30pm

Beginner-6th

Sun. - 11:00am to 12:15pm

Youth Ministry: 7th-12th

Sunday- 6:00pm-8:00pm

All classes will begin on September 18th *Wednesday classes on Sept. 14th

Registration for 2011-2012 will begin during the last two class sessions of the current year on:

- **April 6th & 13th (Wed.) and April 10th & 17th (Sun.)** at the front desk of the Education Building for all grade levels.
- **May 15th & 22nd** after all Masses, in the Family Life Center.
- **9:00am-4:00pm, Tues.-Fri.** at the C.C.E. office.
- **Forms will also be available on the St. Michael's website:** www.smlj.org
- **DEADLINE for all 2011-2012 registrations will be July 15, 2011.**

****Any registrations received after July 15th will be placed on a waiting list and processed on a first come- first served basis.***

Students will be placed in classes as space is available. You will be notified no later than September 2nd as to whether your child will be placed in a class. If there is no space available you will be given the opportunity to instruct your child at home with grade-level books and lessons, as stated in the Archdiocesan Home-School Guidelines.

The following requirements are necessary in order for your registration to be complete and processed.

1. Copy of child's baptismal/sacramental certificates, if not received at St. Michael's
****Required for 2nd & 11th grades Sacramental Preparation years.***
2. Completion of all registration forms.
3. Payment of Registration and Materials fee for:

<u>St. Michael's Registered Parishioners:</u>	<u>Not registered or Out-of-Parish</u>
• \$35 for 1 child	\$60 for 1 child
• \$65 for 2 children	\$90 for 2 children
• \$95 for 3 or more children	\$120 for 3 or more children

- ***Families needing financial assistance will need to submit the Scholarship Form.***
- ***A minimum of \$5 per child must be paid by the family.***
- ***For a payment plan, see the CCE Coordinator.***

In order to offer a religious education program that truly helps parents in the faith formation of their children, it is necessary to plan for the students in advance, and for parents and other adult parishioners to accept the call to catechist/volunteer ministry. Please prayerfully consider this important ministry and contact the CCE/Youth Ministry offices office with any questions or to volunteer.
