

THE SOLEMNITY OF ALL SAINTS

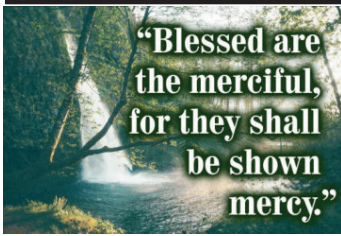

SOLEMNITY OF ALL SAINTS

Dear Parish Family,

Today we begin to celebrate two great feasts of the church- All Saints Day which is today and All Souls Day celebrated tomorrow. Frequently the word saint conjures up ecstatic visions and extraordinary miracles. We sometimes think that sainthood does not apply to us as ordinary mortals. Time and again the phrase "eternal happiness" suggests remote people not in touch with our everyday lives. Yet the celebration of All Saints is supposed to remind us that we are a community with a sense of history, a sense of pride, and a sense of continuity. Against the background of All Saints, St. Matthew shows in the gospel of the feast day that the kingdom of God is made up of real people and describes the heroism required of all members of Jesus' kingdom. The merciful, the single-hearted, and the peacemakers have the credentials for such membership. Do we have the faith and courage necessary to be part of the kingdom?

And then there's All Souls. I think it used to be called Poor Souls but the name changed as the church reminded us that they were on their way to heaven after Purgatory. The day seemed so sad and sometimes it was one of those chilly and dreary days of Fall. Life and Death. Childhood dreams and adult tears. What does it mean?

It is a good and wholesome thing to think about, to remember.....and to pray to God for those who have gone before us. May they Rest In Peace!!!

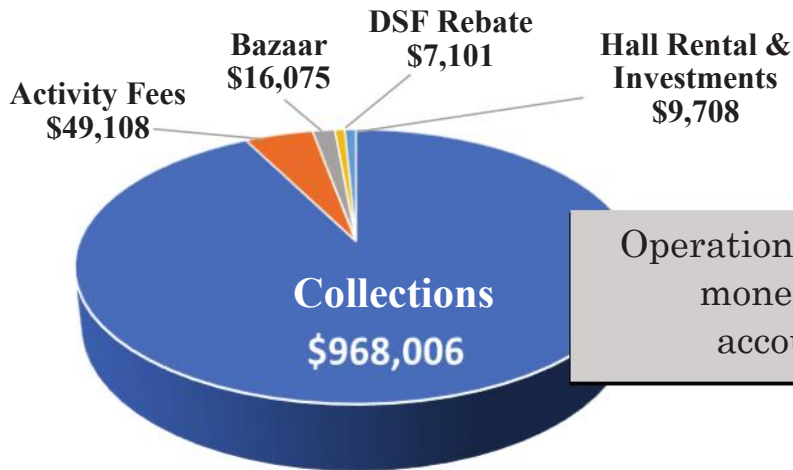

St. Michael the Archangel Treasure Stewardship July 2019 - June 2020

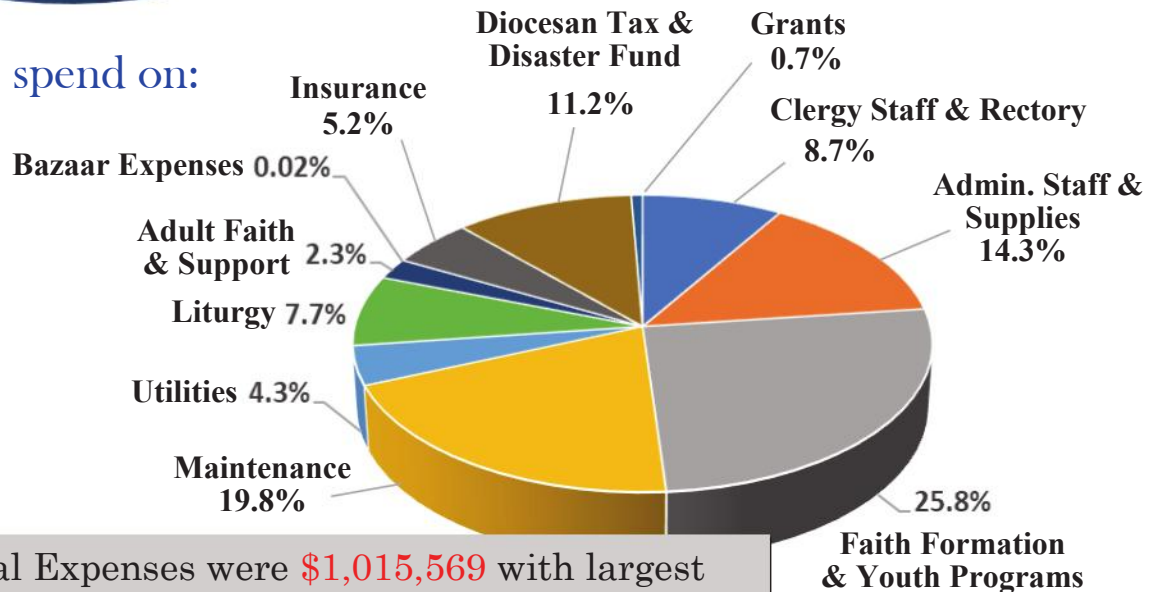
Each year as we examine the stewardship of our time, talent and treasure, a detailed report is made available to the parishioners of St. Michael's. Below is a snapshot of the report. These numbers exclude IGNITE related funding and expenditures.



Where our Operational Funding comes from:

Operational Income was **\$1,049,998** with money received from collections accounting for 92% of income.

What we spend on:



Operational Expenses were **\$1,015,569** with largest portions on Faith Formation & Youth Programs (26%), Maintenance (20%) and Admin. Staff & Supplies (14%)

Operational income decreased 14% primarily due to the COVID-19 pandemic with no bazaar (\$63,000 impact) and reduced collections (\$98,000 impact).

Operational expenses were down 22% primarily due to less clergy / staffing during the year, no bazaar expenses and no summer youth activities because of COVID-19. Income was \$34,429 more than expenses. Major capital expenses included rectory renovations and new parking curbs. Unfortunately, we are **projecting a deficit for the coming year** but are working such that over this past year and the present year operational income and expenses are balanced.

Potential Confirmation Students! WHAT DO WE NEED TO DO TO HAVE OUR BABY (CHILD) BAPTIZED?

NOTE: If your child is 7 years or older, please call the office immediately as the process for your child is different than the one below.



1. Contact the Parish office or read the information posted on our parish website under the Baptism tab:

- A) Parents are strongly encouraged to be registered parishioners at St. Michael, therefore you need a parish registration form (that can be picked up from the office or download from the parish website.)
- B) Parents need to fill a Baptismal Application and,
- C) The godparent form is to be filled and signed by the godparent him/herself.
- D) Only one godparent is required but 2 can be accepted (one male and one female.)

NOTE: Parents MUST read the godparent requirements before choosing a godparent.

2. Pre-Baptism Class:

A) Parents and Godparents must attend a Pre-Baptismal class.

B) At St. Michael classes are scheduled for the months of February, April, June, August and October.

C) Call the parish office 979-297-3041 or send an email to claudia@smlj.org or melanie@smlj.org to register for the class date you wish to attend!

Classes may be taken at another parish, but a certificate of completion is necessary for paperwork.

3. Reserve a Date for the Baptism:

A) All paperwork must be completed and all requisites met, in order to reserve a baptismal date.

B) If you attend Mass at another parish but are requesting to baptize at St. Michael, parents must present a letter of permission from the parish where they usually attend Mass.

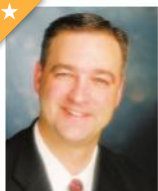
