What is this program?

The Presence: The Mystery of the Eucharist program is a four-week program with the goal of reinvigorating the belief of the Real Presence of Jesus Christ within Mass.

Why are we doing this program?

Presence: The Mystery of the Eucharist is a response to recent research that indicates that only two-thirds of Catholic believe in the Real Presence as taught by the Church.

When will the program be held?

The program will run during Lent, 2024, for a period of four weeks.

How is the program organized?

The basic organization of the program is via small faith-sharing groups.

How do I join the program?

Joining the program is via registration. Primarily, registration will be online. As an infrequent backup, a physical form can be provided for manual registration.

Where will group meetings be held?

Group meetings will be held in homes, or alternately in classrooms at the parish.

Who will lead the groups?

A trained facilitator will lead each group.

What days & times will be offered?

Pending participant demand, classes will be held each day of the week (Sunday through Saturday). There will be potential morning and/or evening sessions.

Who should participate in this program?

All parishioners are welcome and encouraged to join. Less experienced Catholics can learn more about what Church teaches about the Real Presence. For longer-term Catholics, the program can serve to renew the belief in the Real Presence.
